Directions for Android Overdrive App

1. Get free Overdrive App from Android Marketplace.
2. Get an Adobe ID: adobe.com > Sign In > Create Account.
3. Launch Overdrive app, authorize device with Adobe ID.

Download eBooks:

4. Open the Overdrive App and tap *Get Books*.
5. Tap *Add a Library* and find Nashville Public Library.
6. Check out: Choose *EPUB eBook* > *Add to Cart* > *Proceed to Check Out* > *Sign In* > *Select Lending Period* > *Confirm Check Out* > *Download Now*.
7. Read: Open the Overdrive App and tap *Bookshelf*. Tap a title to begin reading.
8. Return early: Tap *Edit* and tap the red minus sign. Return and delete the book.

Directions for Android Kindle App*

1. Get Kindle App from Android Marketplace.
2. Sign in with Amazon Account.

Download eBooks:

3. On your computer or tablet, browse the library's eBook collection: <http://emedia.library.nashville.org>
4. Check out: Choose *Kindle Book* > *Add to Cart* > *Proceed to Check Out* > *Sign In* > *Select Lending Period* > *Confirm Check Out* > Tap *Get for Kindle*
5. Sign in to Amazon.com > *Get library book*. Book will be delivered to your device over wi-fi.
6. Read: Open Kindle App. Tap *Home* or *Archived Items*.
7. Return early: Go to Amazon.com > *Manage Your Kindle*. Choose *Return this book* from *Actions* menu.

* If you are unable to access Kindle Books on your smartphone, use a computer or tablet to browse and checkout Kindle Books. Books will still be delivered to your mobile device over wi-fi.
